Prof. Godwin is a young but experienced multidisciplinary scholar-practitioner of good repute with over 25 years' experience and over 27 professional qualifications, from both Nigeria and international professional bodies. He is the co-founder and the Chief Technical Consultant at OGE Professional Services Ltd, President at OGE Business School, Principal Partner at Oyedokun Godwin Emmanuel & Co (Chartered Accountants), Principal Partner at OGE Professional Services (Certified National Accountant and Tax Consultants). Godwin is a Professor of Forensic Accounting & Finance at Charisma University, Turks & Caicos Island, West Indies, UK. An Adjunct Professor at the Department of Accounting, Igbinedion University, Okada, Nigeria, an Adjunct Professor in the Department of Management & Accounting of Lead City University Ibadan Nigeria, a Visiting Professor at the Department of Management Science of Coal City University, Enugu and a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Accounting at Nasarawa State University Keffi, and he was a one-time adjunct lecturer at Babcock University, a part-time Lecturer at South-Western University and McPherson University, all in Nigeria to mention a few.

Prof. Godwin is currently a Faculty member for the supervision of Postgraduate Students at the University of South Africa (UNISA). He is also an External Examiner for undergraduate programme of the Accountancy Department, Faculty of Business Administration, Abia State University, Uturu Nigeria.

Prof. Godwin had attended several local and international conferences in the last 25 years with over 40 professional articles and 127 peered-reviewed academic articles, and 14 conference papers to his credit and he had contributed to more than ten textbooks and have 12 books to his credit. He has successfully supervised as a sole supervisor, 48 BSc Projects, 5 PGD Projects, 20 MSc Dissertations, and 37 completed Ph.D. research works in management, accounting, finance, taxation and forensic accounting & audit in Nigeria and overseas.

Dame Gladys Olajumoke Simplice started her academic career at Araromi Baptist School, Moloney, Lagos while her secondary education was at the Methodist Girls High School, Yaba, Lagos and Premier Grammar School, Lafenwa, Abeokuta. She commenced her Higher School Certificate (HSC) with Adeola Odutola College, Ijebu-ode and finished at the Saint Gregory's College, Obalende, Lagos. Thereafter, she proceeded to Ahmadu Bello University, Samaru, Zaria where she graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Economics.

She started her training in Accountancy with the firm of A B Alabi & Co/Alabi Bakoh Ekundare & Co. (Chartered Accountants and Secretaries). She was thereafter employed as an Assistant Accountant at a Private Fisheries Company, Transcontinental Fisheries Ltd in Lagos.

In August 1982, Dame Simplice commenced her tax career with the Federal Inland Revenue Department, (now Federal Inland Revenue Service) and retired after 27 years of a fulfilling and meritorious service. Due to her diligence during her service years, she was given a contract appointment as Head, Channels Management of the Corporate Communication Department of FIRS in 2009. She made a lot of improvement in the Department and initiated the idea of a Revenue Museum which is still a work in progress at FIRS.

She played a strong supportive role in the development of the Chartered Institute of Taxation of Nigeria since 1982 and she has not looked back in terms of her total commitment to the Institute till date. She has successfully headed several Committees of Council and was until her election as the 14th President of the CITN, the Chairman Finance and General Purposes Committee.


